

Regular Meeting Minutes

Crime Stoppers of Clark County WI, Inc

May 27, 2026, 9:00 A.M.

Loyal City Hall, Meeting Room, Loyal WI 54446, AND VIA Zoom Connection

1. The Regular meeting of Crime Stoppers of Clark County WI was called to order by President Peter Kaz at 9:00 a.m. Roll call taken. Board Members Present: Peter Kaz, and Sheila Nyberg. Present via Zoom - Natalie Erpenbach, Jason Bourget, Lindsey Stump, Scott Cullen and Matt Frane. All members present. Also, present via Zoom – Detective Captain Nathan Schneiber of the Clark County Sheriff's Department.
2. Motion to approve the Agenda made by Frane and seconded by Stump. Voice vote, all aye, motion carried.
3. President's Report
Kaz reported that the WI State Crime Stoppers Annual Convention will be held in October 2026 in Appleton. That agenda does NOT include any presentation from Clark County Crime Stoppers or it's Sheriff's Department. Our Chapter will likely be asked for a \$500 payment in support of the Convention. Kaz also reported that he plans on being at the Abbotsford Dairy breakfast on May 31st.
4. Secretary's Report
Motion by Cullen, second by Bourget to approve the Minutes of April 22, 2026, as presented. Voice vote, all aye, motion carried.
5. Treasurer's Report
Review of reports from Treasurer - Erpenbach. The Checkbook has \$6,526.54 as of today. No payables and net equity of \$6,526.54. No changes from prior month's report. Motion by Stump and seconded by Cullen to approve the Treasurer's Report. Voice vote, all aye, motion carried.
6. Sheriff's Department – Detective Captain Schreiber reported that there were not a lot of tips reported lately. Most tips are “driving complaints”. Schreiber reported that the Department staff was preparing flyers (cybersecurity / drug related) and that they will be available for Facebook posting shortly.
7. Facebook / Advertising / Promotional
Discussed Facebook – Note – we all individually, need to help with our social media posts by liking, commenting, and sharing these posts. Stump is posting or sharing Facebook items as appropriate. Stump and Cattnach discussed procedures currently in place.
