Regular Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman Scott Cullen, called the meeting to order @ 7 PM.

Meeting minutes from June 8th, 2026, were accepted by Gilbert Voelker and seconded by Edward Irish. All Aye.

Chairman Scott Cullen opened 3 bids received for chip seal patching and crack sealing.

- **Scott Construction Inc.** – Lake Delton, WI - **BID ACCEPTED**

*Option 1 – Double Chip Seal over 3 spots on Dickerson Ave. - \$9,500.00

***Option 2 – Cold Mix Paver Patching over 3 spots on Dickerson Ave. - \$9,350.00**

Crack Sealing using 100% Crafcro Polyfiber Type 3 Sealant

***Crack Sealing -\$8,140 / Cross Crack Dip Leveling \$11,855 Total: \$19,995.00**

Crack filling & Dip leveling numbers are for Willard Road (Hwy M – Dickerson Ave), Dickerson Ave (Willard Road – Butler Road (Dickerson-Rod & Gun Club).

- **Fahrner Asphalt Sealers** –

*Dickerson Ave. - \$9,969.00

*Crack Sealing - \$8,400.00 or Alternate \$14,800.00

Gilbert Voelker made a motion to accept the bid from Scott Construction Inc.; Ed Irish seconded it.

Tom Martens had asked what the township could do for him due to an out lot being blocked off.

A discussion regarding out lots 3,4,5,6 and the blocking of these out lots was had. It was determined that the Township of Foster has no jurisdiction over this issue. They are not maintained by the township so are not township roads and are intended as access ways to the abutting properties. Personal property owners will be directed to look at their deeds and handle any discrepancies amongst themselves.

Bid notices will be going out for building a 24 ft. wide x 30 ft. long salt shed with a 10 ft. apron slab.

Sloping roof with a 25 ft. front and 18 ft. back. To be done by November. A motion to accept this was made by Gilbert Voelker and seconded by Ed Irish.

Road & Equipment report given by Ed Irish. All roads are in good shape. Dickerson Ave. is in good shape with the new gravel. Blue Karner “No mow” signs will be put up this week. Looking into having township vehicles rust proofed. The newly sealed town shop roof had some leaks during the hard rain, so John Harms painting has been notified, and they will be coming back to repatch those areas.
